INTRODUCTION

Labor Relations is a management specialty concerned with all aspects of the employment relationship— in particular with, an organization’s maintenance of the human resources necessary to achieve organizational objectives. As an academic discipline and profession, Labor Relations is an interdisciplinary, problem-solving field whose practitioners attempt to maintain harmony and resolve conflicts among employees, employers, government and where applicable, unions.



FORMAT

Earn both a **Masters Degree in Labor Relations** and a **Graduate Certificate in Human Resource Management** in just 14 months! This 30 credit program is a modular lock-step curriculum, in a collaborative learning environment. You take and complete one course in a five-week increment. Each course is a building block for the next. The same group of students remains together for the entire program in a seminar style. Classes meet on Saturdays from 8:30am to 3:30pm, one day a week at our **West Haven** location starting in September 2011.



REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for admission to this program are required to hold a four-year baccalaureate degree (or equivalent) from an accredited institution. An undergraduate degree in business is not a requirement; qualified students from all backgrounds are encouraged to submit applications. In addition, applicants must have two years of professional experience.
